PROCEEDINGS:

Tamil Nadu Electricity Board has been trifurcated into three Corporations viz., TNEB Limited, Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited and Tamil Nadu Transmission Corporation Limited, as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.100 Energy (B2) Department dated 19.10.2010, and the Corporations are being governed by Companies Act (1956) which come under the ambit of Electricity Act, 2003, the hitherto followed rules, regulations, system etc., have to be revised as stipulated in the above said acts.

2. Accordingly as approved by Board in the proceedings third read above orders were issued for conducting the departmental tests by Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited which were conducted for Tamil Nadu Electricity Board employees by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

3. The Government of Tamil Nadu in its orders fourth read above, issued orders bringing the TANGEDCO, TANTRANSCO and TNEB LTD outside the purview of TNPSC for conducting the Departmental tests for the employees of TANGEDCO and also directed to determine its own internal arrangements for conducting examinations to its employees.

4. The TANGEDCO is paying the fees for the examination centers based on the number of persons applied to the departmental tests and an average of 20% of employees noticed absent in all the examinations. This shows that the applicants are not giving much importance to the departmental tests which is being conducted without collecting any fees. Hence a proposal for collecting the fees for creating awareness among the employees has been considered.

5. Accordingly it is hereby ordered that
- a. A non-transferable, non-refundable, examination fee of Rs.100/- be collected per subject at the concerned Superintending Engineer's office. The details of payment should be clearly incorporated in the application itself.
 - b. Applications for appearing for the examination together with the receipt for the payment of fees should reach the office on or before the notified date.
 - c. The responsibility of paying the amount lies with the individuals only.
 - d. The payment of examination fees/writing of examination does not ensure any special eligibility for promotion.
 - e. Any other mode of payment will not be entertained.
 - f. The procedure prescribed in the proceedings first read above for refund of fees is dispensed with.
