Guidelines for taking Photo, Digital Signature and ID Card

1. Photograph Requirements :

Please pay attention to upload good quality photograph. Poor quality of the photograph submitted will lead to rejection of your application, without any refund of the application fee.

- The photograph must be in colour and must be taken in a professional studio. Photograph taken using a mobile phone and other self-composed portraits are NOT acceptable.
- The photograph must be taken in a white or a very light background.
- The photograph must have been taken recently (within 1 year).
- In the photograph, the face should occupy about 50% of the area, and with a full-face view looking into the camera directly.
- The main features of the face must not be covered by hair of the head, any cloth or any shadow. Forehead, eyes, nose and chin should be clearly visible.
- If you normally wear spectacles, glare on glasses is not acceptable in your photo. Glare can be avoided with a slight downward tilt of the glasses or by removing the glasses for the photo shoot.
- You must not wear spectacles with dark or tinted glasses, only clear glasses are permitted.
- The passport size photograph should be in JPEG/GIF/JPG/TIF format of file size between 20 KB to 30 KB.
- Maximum pixel resolution for JPEG: 640 × 480 (0.3 Mega pixel) (Ask your studio to reduce it to this resolution if it is higher).
- Minimum pixel resolution for JPEG: 320 × 240.

2. Signature Specifications

- Please draw a rectangular box of size 4 cm x 2 cm on an A4 white paper. Put your signature with black or dark blue ink pen within this box.
- Get the signature digitally image scanned by a professional using a scanner, and get the image cropped to the box by the professional.
- The scanned signature and the signature in the ID card (Permanent / Temporary) should be the same.
- The file should be in JPEG/GIF/JPG/TIF format of file size between 10 KB to 20 KB.
- The maximum pixel resolution for the image is 800×300 .
- The minimum pixel resolution for the image is 400×150 .
- Photographs of the signatures taken using mobile phone are not acceptable, and can result in disqualification of the application without any refund of the fee.

3. ID Card:

- Scan both sides of the Departmental ID card (on the same page)
- The file should be in JPEG/GIF/JPG/TIF format of file size between 50KB to 100KB.
